NCJW, LA serves more than 12,000 individuals through our Community Mental Health and Supportive Services, Scholarships, Youth Educational Programs and Services, Back 2 School Store, intern training programs and our clothing assistance projects. To qualify, an applicant must be re-entering or continuing school in order to learn a marketable skill which will lead to economic self-sufficiency. The applicant must be a woman 25 years of age or older for whom the opportunity to return to school will lead to economic independence. The applicant can be either married or single, with or without children. The National Council of Jewish Women | Los Angeles (NCJW | LA) provides scholarships to those who live and attend school in the Greater Los Angeles area, including Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and Ventura Counties.
