

# Best Student Discounts to Use in College



Being a student can stretch your patience, time management, and bank account, but did you know that it also comes with some perks? Here are some of the **best student discounts to use in college during 2026**. All titles in bold are clickable links. *Note: Discounts listed below may be subject to change at any time.*



## Arts & Entertainment

- [\*\*AMC Theaters\*\*](#) offers discounted tickets with a valid college ID (locations may vary).
- [\*\*Art Institute of Chicago\*\*](#) discounts the admission rate for students. Admission rates may vary depending on where you live or attend college.
- [\*\*California Museum\*\*](#) offers tickets at a discounted rate with a valid student ID.
- [\*\*Carnegie Hall\*\*](#) lets students with a valid student ID purchase \$10 tickets to select shows.
- [\*\*Cinemark\*\*](#) offers discounted tickets with a valid student ID (locations may vary).
- [\*\*Denver Art Museum\*\*](#) offers a reduced admission rate for students who are Colorado residents and out-of-state residents.
- [\*\*Lincoln Center New York\*\*](#) offers a variety of student discounts, including free and discounted "student rush" tickets and discounted memberships.
- [\*\*Peacock Premium Streaming Service\*\*](#) cuts its \$8 monthly subscription down to \$2 per month for students.
- [\*\*Regal Movie Theatres\*\*](#) offers discounted pricing to students with a valid ID at the time of purchase (locations may vary).
- [\*\*Metropolitan Museum of Art\*\*](#) offers student tickets at a discounted rate.
- [\*\*The Museum of Fine Arts Houston\*\*](#) offers free admission to college students attending selected Houston-area colleges, and to art students working on an assigned project.
- [\*\*Universal Studios Hollywood\*\*](#) offers discounted park passes to students attending partner universities.
- Amusement parks, museums, concert halls, zoos, and other venues often provide discounted tickets to colleges and universities in their local area. Check with your school's student life office to find out what's available.



## Electronics & Software

- **Adobe** offers a 64% discount for students and teachers on Adobe Creative Cloud.
- **Adorama** offers discounts to students who sign up for their college discount program.
- **Apple** cuts the price on Macs, iPads and Accessories and Apple Care for college students (and their parents) year round. Look for the "Education Pricing" symbol to find eligible products.
- **AT&T** offers savings of up to \$10/month per line on AT&T Unlimited Premium.
- **Avid** offers education pricing for students on Pro Tools, Media Composer, and Sibelius.
- **Best Buy** gives students exclusive deals when they sign up for a "My Best Buy" account.
- **Codecademy** gives eligible college students a 35% discount on Codecademy Pro.
- **Dell** gives college or university students a percentage off sitewide.
- **HP** offers student deals when you sign up for an account in the HP Education Store.
- **Lenovo** gives verified students a 5% discount on products site-wide.
- **Logitech** offers a 25% discount on all tech products to verified students through UniDays.
- **Microsoft** offers a variety of discounts for students, including 50% off Office 365 Personal, free access to Microsoft Teams, and up to 10% off select items.
- **Samsung** gives students who sign up for its Education Offers Program a 30% discount on select products.
- **Squarespace** offers college students 50% off your first annual subscription.
- **US Mobile** grants students 20% off any plan as well as student-specific perks when they sign up with an .edu address.
- **Verizon** gives students varying discounts on phone plans and internet service.



## Apps, Music, & Media

- **Amazon** offers six months of Amazon Prime free for students. After that period, students are eligible for a discounted rate with all Amazon Prime Student benefits.
- **Apple Music** offers college students a discounted monthly rate for up to 48 months. The student subscription also includes Apple TV+ for a limited time. To be eligible, students must be pursuing a bachelor's degree or be enrolled in an equivalent higher-education program.
- **Babbel** offers a student discount of 65% on 3 months of Babbel language-learning.
- **Headspace** offers 85% off well-being resources (mindfulness, sleep, breathing, happiness, etc.), making the plan \$9.99/year for students verified with SheerID
- **Pandora** offers verified students a 60-day free trial for Pandora Premium Student. After the trial, U.S. students pay \$5.99/month.
- **Peloton** offers a special discount for students on the Peloton app, which includes workout videos and more.
- **SoundCloud** offers verified students a 30-day free trial of SoundCloud Go+ then 50% off per month.
- **Spotify** offers eligible college students a discount on Student Premium.
- **The Economist** offers students 75% off an annual digital subscription. Students can also get access to their *Espresso* newsletter for free.
- **The New York Times** offers a discounted introductory subscription. You can get digital access to The NY Times for \$1/week for a year.
- **The Wall Street Journal** offers a significant discount off its regular subscription rates. While attending school, students may purchase a digital subscription for \$4 a month for one year or a print and digital subscription for \$10 a month.
- **YouTube Premium** offers verified students a one-month free trial. After the trial period is over, students can pay \$7.99/month, which is a savings of \$6/month.



## Retail

- **1-800 Contacts** offers 10% off purchases and free shipping when registered with UNiDAYs.
- **Adidas** offers U.S. students a special discount and free shipping on online orders.
- **Aeropostale** offers students an extra 15% off sitewide. Verify your student status with UNiDAYs.
- **Aerie** offers students 20% off their entire purchase if they are registered with UNiDAYs.
- **Amazon** offers six months free of Amazon Prime student.
- **ASOS** offers a 10% discount that's valid until students graduate.
- **Blick** offers 10% off art supplies with a student ID and Preferred Customer Card.
- **Converse** occasionally offers a 10% to 20% discount on selected products if you verify your student status on their site.
- **Crocs** offers a 25% discount if you verify your student status with ID.me.
- **EyeBuyDirect** offers a percentage off lenses for students.
- **FedEx** offers up to 40% savings if you're verified with StudentBeans and you open a new FedEx account.
- **Goodwill** sometimes offers discounts to students, although discounts vary by store and region. **Goodwill Southwest Pennsylvania**, for example offers currently enrolled students 25% off their entire purchase on Tuesdays when they present a valid student ID. They also offer other shopping discounts throughout the week.
- **J.Crew** offers a 15% discount for students with a valid college ID.
- **Kate Spade** offers a 15% to 85% discount to students. You will need to verify your status with UNiDAYs.
- **Levi's** offers students 15% off online orders.
- **Madewell** offers a 15% discount for students online and in-store.
- **Nike** offers a 10% discount to eligible high school, college, and university students in the United States, who verify their student status with SheerID.
- **Purple** offers students a 10% discount on mattresses.
- **Redbubble** offers a 15% discount for students.
- **Reebok** offers students up to a 72% discount if you're verified with StudentBeans.
- **Stanley** offers students 20% off online if you verify your student status with ID.me.
- **Target** provides a 50% discount to verified college students on Target Circle memberships, which unlock a variety of product discounts.
- **The North Face** offers a 10% discount to eligible college students in the U.S.
- **Tommy Hilfiger** offers students 15% off in-store and online.
- **Vera Bradley** offers a 10% discount online.
- **Vineyard Vines** offers 15% off for all college and grad students.



## Food & Dining

- **Blue Apron** offers a \$110 coupon and free shipping on your first order when you verify your student status with ID.me.
- **DoorDash** offers a Student DashPass Plan at \$4.99/month, which is a savings of \$5/month.
- **EveryPlate** offers 75% off your first student meal kit box, free shipping, and an on-going 15% discount that can be applied for one year, if you are registered with UNiDAYs.
- **HelloFresh** offers 55% off your first food subscription box, free shipping, and an on-going 15% discount that can be applied for one year, if you are registered with UNiDAYs.
- **Home Chef** offers 50% off your first four boxes, which is equivalent to free food for 18 meals when you verify your student status with Student Beans.
- Many fast food restaurants offer a 10% discount to students, although locations and discounted items may vary. These include chains such as **Chic-Fil-A**, **Arby's**, **Chipotle**, **McDonald's**, **Subway**, **Dunkin'** and **Taco Bell**. You may have to ask about the discount and show a valid college ID.
- Pizza purveyors **Papa John**, **Dominos** and **Pizza Hut** also offer student discounts – and your local, independently run pizza joint may have special offers for students.



## Insurance

- **Allstate** offers discounted car insurance rates for full-time, unmarried students under the age of 25. Visit Allstate's website or talk to your local agent to learn more.
- **American Family Insurance** offers a "good student" discount for students between the ages of 16 and 25 who are enrolled in high school or a two- or four-year college. Students must maintain a minimum of a "B" average and be on the dean's list, honor roll, or equivalent list highlighting their academic standing. Talk to your local agent to see if you qualify.
- **Farmers Insurance** offers full-time students under the age of 25 a Farmers Student Discount if they have qualifying grades or test scores.
- **Geico** gives full-time students in good academic standing 15% off of some coverages. Talk to your local agent for more information.
- **Nationwide Insurance** offers a discount to students between the ages of 16 and 24 on their car insurance if they maintain a "B" average or higher. Students must be full-time high school or college students to qualify for the student insurance discount rate.
- **Progressive** offers insurance discounts for full-time students under the age of 23, who maintain a "B" average or higher or drive while they are under the age of 18. Students attending college 100 miles or more from home may also qualify for a discount. Discounts vary by state.
- **State Farm** offers drivers under 25 discounted insurance if they maintain good grades, attend college 100 miles or more from home, or enroll in State Farm's driver training program.
- **USAA** offers a good student discount to drivers under the age of 25 who have a 3.0 or better GPA. USAA also accepts qualifying students who are on the dean's list, on the honor roll, or in the top 20% of their class.



## Transportation

- On **Amtrak**, students receive a 15% discount on train travel and other purchases.
- **GM** offers a college discount to current college undergraduate and graduate students and to those who have graduated from a two- or four-year college within the last two years. Qualified buyers can purchase or lease select automobiles at a discounted price, below MSRP.
- **New Jersey Transit** offers 25% off monthly passes to students attending colleges that participate in its University Partnership Program. Visit N.J. Transit's website to see if your school is included.
- **Penske** offers a 10% discount on truck rentals, which you can use when you're moving in and out.
- Many bike sharing services offer student discounts and/or partner with universities to offer bike share or near campuses. For example **Metro Bike Share** in Los Angeles offers a 30-Day pass for \$5 per month or a yearly pass for \$50 to college students.
- **Student Universe** offers students discounted rates on international airfares, hotels, and rental cars.
- **United** offers a 5% discount on flights for college-aged travelers (aged 18-23) by signing up for a free Mileage Plus account in the United app.
- **Zipcar** provides discounted hourly and daily on-demand car sharing to students attending any of their hundreds of partner universities. Discounts may vary by college.
- And don't forget, your local public transportation agency may offer student discounts through your college or university.



## Cell Phone Providers

- **AT&T** offers savings of up to \$10/month per line to students at qualifying colleges and universities.
- **Verizon** offers students a savings of \$12/line on mobile plans and \$20/month on home internet plans.

You can find student discounts by searching online or visiting sites such as **UNiDAYs** and **Student Beans**. They offer student discounts in stores and online on dozens of brands of clothing, entertainment, technology, and more. Restaurants, stores, and other businesses, both local and nationwide, may offer student discounts even if they don't advertise them. So, no matter where you shop, **ask if a student discount is available**. Always carry your student ID with you, so you can verify your student status.
